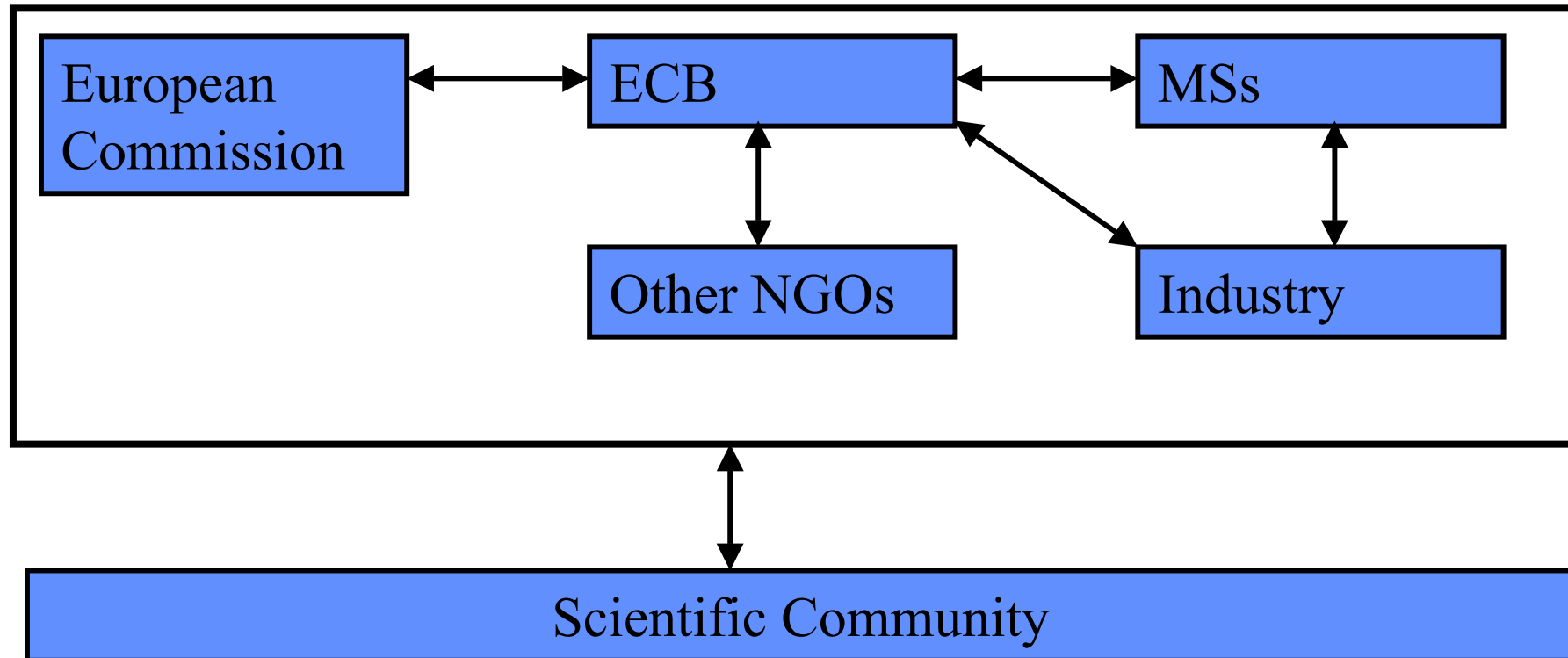
Science Needs to Improve *LINKS*:

- basic research – applied research

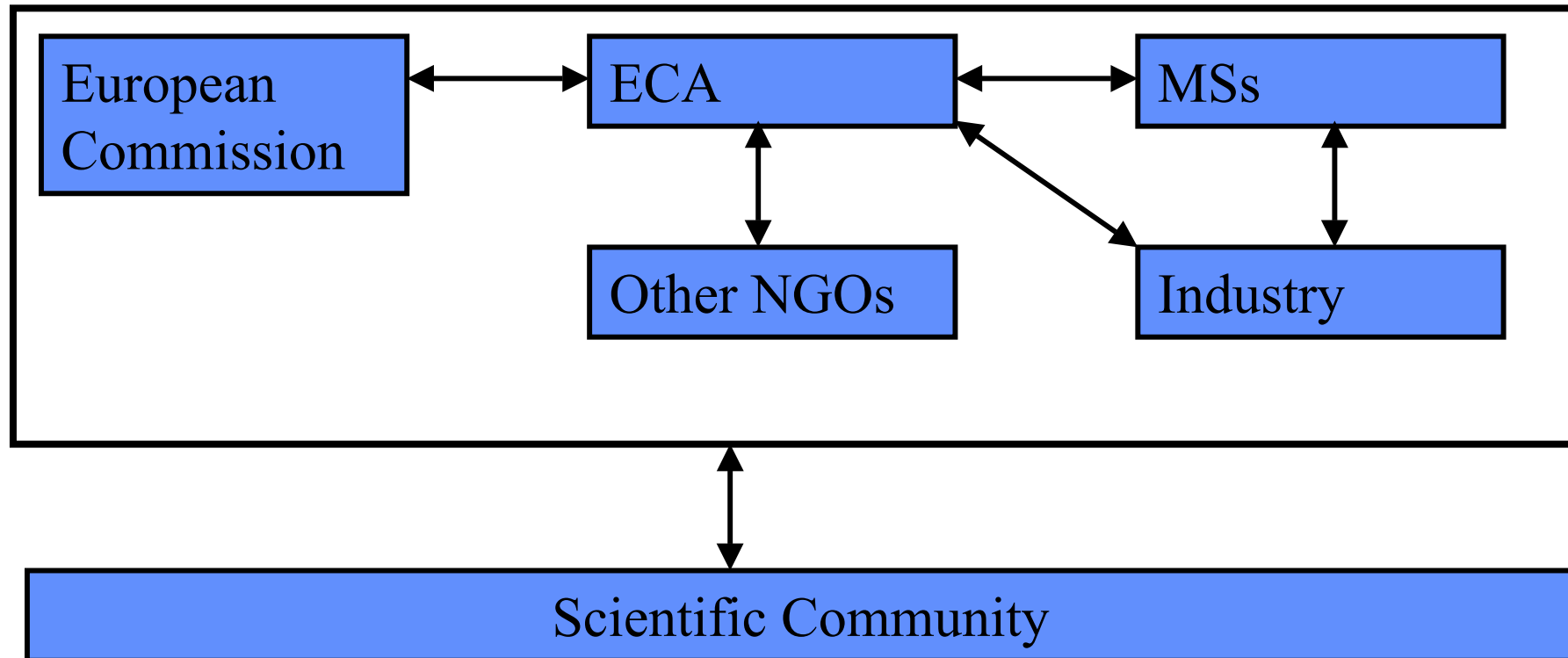
BUT Science ALSO Needs to Improve *LINKS*:
