In December '03 the Microtox M500 from SDI received it's Verification Report and Statement from the EPA's ETV Program Test of Rapid Toxicity Technologies.

EPA's Environmental Technology Verification (ETV) Program develops testing protocols and verifies the performance of innovative technologies that have the potential to improve protection of human health and the environment. The Goal of this program is to generate credible 3rd-party performance data so that buyers and users of environmental technologies can make informed purchase, application, and permitting decisions.

ETV was created to accelerate the entrance of new environmental technologies into the domestic and international marketplace.

Recently, ETV began verification of monitoring and treatment technologies relevant for homeland security.
